**General Meeting Minutes**

Tommy Parker – August 10, 2007 – Friday, Scrimmage with Orange High School. Prior to football game, we will have a black/white scrimmage game for soccer. We may try to have some other athletic events going as well (volleyball, etc.). This will be a great opportunity to sell sports passes and merchandise. We need to think of a name for the event.

David Guy – we need a committee to start to organize this event. Could have a BBQ and other things going on as well. Could sell BBQ tickets through team members in advance. Marching band could do some practice playing/marching at half time.

Jonathan Tatton will check with Smithfield BBQ on a cost.

Jonathan – Charitable/fundraising event in September.

Tommy – silent auction idea. Half of proceeds go to charity, half go to athletics. People will pay if they know it is going to a cause. Discussed possible charities to which we want to be associated. We discussed other options for fundraisers.

First home football game – August 31.

Next year – hosting Wake County high school track meet on a Saturday in the spring.

January – hosting Wake County cheerleading championships. The money raised through concessions is ours.
